

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: COLLEGE OF FELLOWS 2011

Nominations are sought for the 2011 Class of the APT College of Fellows. The College of Fellows was established in 1992 with the induction of the Founders of the Association as the inaugural class. The Board of Directors and the College will induct the next Class of Fellows at the APT conference in Victoria, British Columbia in October 2011.

The purpose of the College is to recognize members who have made significant contributions to the field of preservation technology and to APT International. Election to the APT College of Fellows is the highest honor bestowed by APT upon a member of the organization.

A jury appointed by the President will evaluate all nominations and elect new Fellows. It is expected that the Fellows-elect will attend the Victoria, BC conference where they will be inducted into the College of Fellows.

The College has established the following requirements for membership.

The candidate must:

- **be a member in good standing of APT and have been a member in good standing for at least five years;**
- **have contributed in a significant way to the advancement of the field of preservation technology;**
- **have contributed in a significant way to the success of a chapter or conferences, training and education activities, publications and/or the administration of APT;**
- **affirm a willingness to work with others for the development and promotion of the College and of APT.**

Nominations may be submitted by the APT Board OR by the board of an APT chapter OR by five APT members.

Nomination applications are to be submitted to the APT Office **electronically** and must include the following files in pdf format **attached to a single email**:

1. a cover sheet indicating the nominating organization or the names of the five APT members making the nomination with the names, addresses, telephone numbers, fax numbers and e-mail addresses of the candidate and the nominator and supporters;
2. a two page letter from the nominator describing how the candidate's specific accomplishments have contributed to the field of preservation technology and what notable work of the candidate has advanced the activities of APT;
3. four letters of support ONLY (preferable one-page in length) by current APT members, focusing on specific aspects of the candidate's achievements personally known to the writers; (all letters should be minimum 10 point type but may be single-spaced.)
4. current curriculum vitae / resume of the candidate;

5. a signed statement from the candidate confirming that she/he accepts the requirements for membership in the College of Fellows outlined above;
6. one reproducible photograph of the candidate, 7" x 3" at 300 dpi

The complete nomination package should be submitted electronically no later than June 15, 2011 and should be addressed to the APT College of Fellows Nominations and Induction Committee through APT Administrative Director Nathela Chatara at nchatara@associationcentral.org
