This position is located in the Historic Architecture Conservation & Engineering Center in Lowell, Massachusetts.

The incumbent serves as a senior level professional Mechanical Engineer in the provision of professional mechanical engineering services, advice, and guidance on the assessment, planning, designing, constructing, expansion, rehabilitation and/or repurposing of existing and/or new structures and facilities.

Project work supports the efforts of client parks in improving visitor experience and protecting and restoring cultural and natural resources. Project work may include, but is not limited to the following type of structures or facilities: historic and interpreted structures, fortifications, visitor centers, museums, curatorial facilities, lodging facilities, employee housing, and administrative structures.

Project work ranges from small, single disciplinary to large multi-disciplinary design and construction contracts, involving both single and multiple-year phasing. The position requires working knowledge and familiarity with related disciplines of engineering such as plumbing, fire protection, environmental, acoustical, and electrical.

The individual will address project demands requiring unique, creative solutions that balance diverse stewardship mandates involving culturally significant resources; particularly with respect to museum collections housed within historic structures.
