



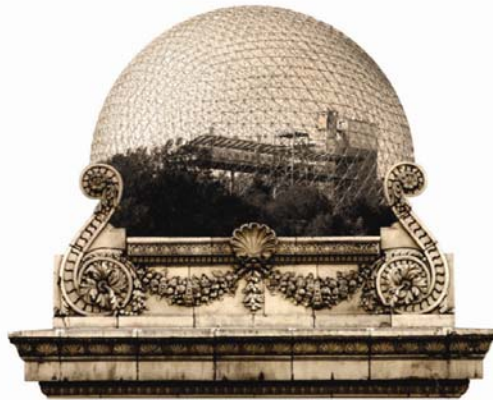

Rates

A reduced rate of \$205CAD* is available to conference attendees for October 11–18, 2008. Mention that you are attending the APT Conference to receive the reduced rate of \$205. The hotel cut off date is September 20, 2008, based on availability. If the block fills before September 20, rooms may not be available at the discounted conference rate.

You can also book a room by clicking on “Book a Room” on line at www.hiltonmontreal.com/eng/html/reservations.asp. The Group/Convention Code is **PTI**. The \$205 CAD* rate is only available October 11–18 so if you enter dates outside that timeframe, you won’t get the reduced rate. Call the hotel to make a reservation that includes days outside the official conference dates.

*In addition to the room rate, the hotel charges a total of 16.26% taxes (3% occupancy tax + 5% Goods and Services Tax (G.S.T.) + 7.5% Provincial Sales Tax (P.S.T.)). The G.S.T. is refundable to non-Canadian residents. Total room cost for one person is \$238.33CAD.

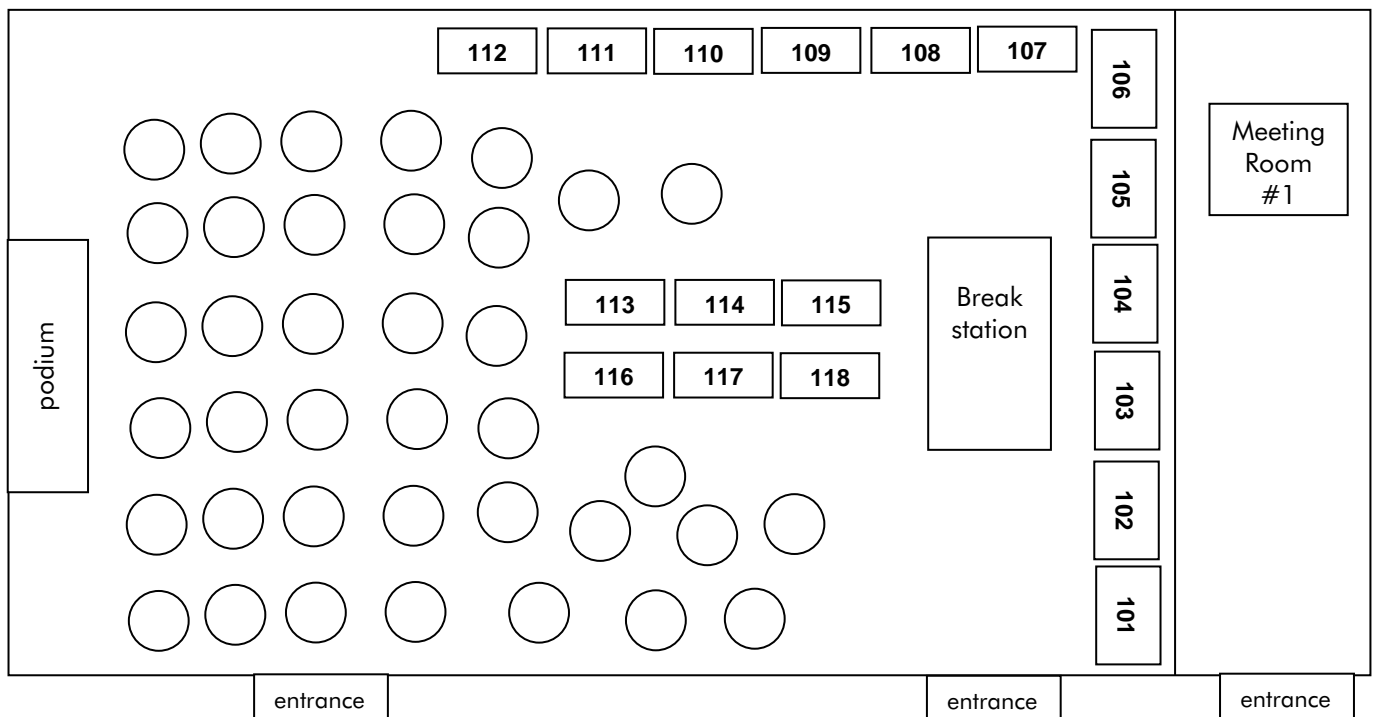
Exhibit Floor Plan
